Received 6 more big envelopes today plus a V-Mail & an air-mail letter - certainly good to hear that everyone back there is fine. Thanks very much for the magazines - should keep me well occupied for the next few days. We are in another rest period and they will help me pass the time away. Took a swell shower yesterday - hot water and I enjoyed it very much - first good shower I had since I left England.

Nappy to know that Carrie, Angie and Sonny had a swell time at the house - they always look forward to their visit to Apt. and mother likes to have them around.

I wrote Jagg & Mary Ricci a letter today - trying to catch up on my letter writing - after ~~being~~ on the go the past few weeks - when I didn't do any letter writing. Will have to write Pec & Radosevic sometime tomorrow.

Had a G.I. show tonight - was real good and everybody had a swell time. Have more shows scheduled for the next few days - plus a "Red Cross Clubmobile" - doughnuts, coffee & music - haven't seen any of them since we left England.

I'm fine and in the best of health - wishing all of you at home the same. Regards to all.
